## Rescue Report Submitted by: Lisa Noel

My typical rescue report contains news of the new dogs and their often sad stories of how they arrived in rescue and then their happy adoption outcomes. This report is unfortunately telling of some recent sad happenings involving our rescue dogs.

Cindy was a five year old female being fostered by Ed and Debbie Fitton for several months. She was being treated for a gastrointestinal issue and learning how to be part of a family. Her past was unknown to us, as her previous owner was hospitalized with brain damage. Sadly in November Cindy had an acute neurological crisis of some sort and became paralyzed and was not expected to recover. Ed, Debbie and Clyde Dunphy agreed that the kindest thing we could do for Cindy was to let her go peacefully. Even though Cindy was a "foster" dog it doesn't make losing her any less, she was dearly loved for the time they had her. A few days after losing Cindy, River King was contacted by her previous owner who was now well and had been "looking" for her since the summer. Her family had placed Cindy with us, not thinking the owner would recover and couldn't tell her where Cindy went. Debbie had to inform Cindy's previous owner about her passing and the issues we had with her. They came to the conclusion that a lot of Cindy's problems may have been her simply grieving for her family that she missed.

In December, Ruby a dog also fostered by Debbie Fitton, had to be euthanized unexpectedly after she became acutely ill with mammary tumors. Ruby had been adopted by a wonderful person from Washington, DC, who drove here to get Ruby. Through Ruby, her owner, Chris met his would be fiancé at the lo-

cal dog park. They had made a trip back this summer and Debbie was able to visit Ruby, Chris and their new family. Ruby was supposed to be in their wedding next summer. Please see the tribute to Ruby on the next page.

Also in December I was thrilled to be getting my many Christmas cards with the previous rescue dogs on them that I get every year. I enjoy seeing the dogs so happy in their new homes. One of these cards came from "Lucy" a brown/white Landseer adopted in Nov. 08 by the Hanses in St. Louis and their two children. Imagine my surprise when a couple days before Christmas I get a phone call from her owners telling me that she has bitten a small child severely and snapped at her own children. This was totally out of her character but something that could not be treated lightly. She could no longer live in her home with kids. After determining there was no medical reason for Lucy's behavior she was humanely euthanized as she could not be rehomed due to the aggression.

So in spite of our best efforts sometimes things don't always have a happy ending.

### Tribute To Ruby

To those who have known or loved Ruby Pennock Lyons, and been loved by her in return:

It is with great sadness that we announce the passing of our friend and dog daughter, Ruby the Newfoundland. A week ago we found a tumor on Ruby's belly that was quickly diagnosed as aggres-

sive malignant breast cancer. This is common in female dogs that have been spayed after adolescence like Ruby (Ruby was a rescued stray and adopted as an adult). Over the course of the last couple of days, Ruby developed a number of other cancer-related issues and most of her vital systems began to quickly shut down, much to our grief. Before her quality of life was further compromised, we took the advice of our veterinarian and let her die in peaceful dignity with us by her side this afternoon.

We will always remember the two short years we had with Ruby: the countless parties on Capitol Hill, playing with her canine & human friends in Stanton & Lincoln Parks, swimming in the ocean, Lake Sara, and the Capitol Reflection Pool, the Williamsburg Newfoundland Parade, roaming the halls of Congress, her love and appreciation of car rides (even just spins around the block), and getting baptized on St. Francis Day. Ruby's greatest accomplishment of all was introducing us to each other in Stanton Park, without which we would not have found the love of our lives. This loving gentle giant will be so very missed.

In addition to us, Ruby is survived by her sister Nelly Angelpants Pennock and her foster parents Debbie & Ed of the River King Newfoundland Club Rescue program.

## MEMORANDUM FOR RIVER KING NEWFOUNDLAND DOG CLUB (RKNC) BOARD OF DIRECTORS

## Storm's Rescue Story By: Heather Woodside Submitted by: Sue Z

This is the story of my first Newfoundland dog. His name is Storm. He is a 6 ½ month old Newfoundland puppy. Storm is a true hero in our families' eyes. On any normal day, my children play in a breezeway/toy room. This play room has two doors and one of those doors leads to the backyard where our two dogs play and roam freely in an almost acre fenced in back yard. I currently have two sons one in which is 7 years old and the other one is 2 years old. My 7 years old was currently away at school during the time of the incident. Darius my 2 year old was playing on the breezeway like any ordinary day in his life. My husband and I were in the back part of our home. Suddenly Storm started to bark uncontrollably our first reaction was "What squirrels is he after now? or Why won't the other dog give him the time of day?" I asked or yelled at Storm to knock it off and to be quiet. However Storm persisted and I finally got up to see what all the fuss was about. I proceeded through the house with not a care in the world except to go yell at a barking dog. During my journey to the back yard I had to go through the breezeway to get to the back yard and Storm. I never made it to Storm because the reason for all of his barking was right in front of my eyes. If you have ever felt the wind knocked out of you this is exactly what I had felt right then and there. My eyes had discovered my son Darius was choking to death. Darius had his whole hand in his mouth. I took his hand out and immediately began to clear his air way with several choking maneuvers. Finally, with swift back thrusts and Darius spit out a Lego man's head. If it was not for this big black beautiful creature my son could have died. My family and I feel truly blessed to have encountered such a fine animal into our lives and will forever be in debt to the dog, Storm that saved our baby. To this day, I still would like to know just how Storms instincts knew Darius was choking. The dog could have been anywhere in the yard at that moment. All my love goes out to you Storm, my rescuing hero. THANKS FOR BEING THERE STORM. Storm is a Newfy puppy, bred by Sue Zientara and out of VN Ch Shadrack's Jubilee CD, TDD, WRD (Leeah), and Ch Shadrack's Council Cup Theory (Theo).

(Unfortunately, not long after this story was submitted, Storm passed away. He died at nine months old from SAS. Maybe it was fate that put him with that family if only for a very brief time so that he could be there to save a life.)
